



COUNSELOR IN TRAINING APPLICATION

CARD's Counselor in Training program will run in conjunction with our summer day camps. Anyone interested in becoming a CIT for the 2017 summer season must fill out this application before consideration.

This is an application form and does not guarantee admission into the CIT program. Because this does not guarantee admission, no payment will be accepted until after official acceptance into the CIT program. In addition, participation in this program does not guarantee employment or readmission in following summers.

All accepted CIT's must:

- Be 14 or 15 years old as of May 31st, 2017.
- Undergo a "staff training" session to provide them with the tools needed to work with campers.
- Present themselves as role models and fully participate in all programs and activities.
- Commit to either CIT 1, CIT 2, CIT 3, or CIT 4.

CIT 1 (6/5-6/30) and CIT 2 (7/10-8/4) participants will be working with our day camp program for children 7-13. One portion of the day will be spent on planned activities while the other portion will be spent at Splash City. This program runs Monday through Friday from 9AM to 5PM.

CIT 3 (6/6-6/29) and CIT 4 (7/11-8/3) participants will be working with our PeeWee camp program for children 3-6 years old. This program runs Tuesday through Thursday from 9AM-12PM.



Please fill out the entire application for consideration into CARD's Counselor in Training program. An application does not guarantee admittance. In addition to the application, an interview will be required. There are a limited number of spots and it is our intention to provide our day campers with the strongest possible CIT participants.
