Willoughby Farm saw the opening of the house and major trail improvements. The farm also had its record number of volunteers and visitors this year. Thank you to all the dedicated volunteers who continue to make this park an outstanding place to visit and learn!

Glidden Park's tennis courts are now repaired! Utilizing local grants, the tennis courts are once again a great place for recreation. The project earned CARD the Carl Schultze Improvement of the Month award for October from Collinsville Progress. There have also been numerous park improvements throughout the District, and the newer parks of Pleasant Ridge and the Arlington Wetlands continue to exceed visitor expectations.

PARK INFORMATION & FACILITY RENTAL

Looking for a place to party? The Collinsville Area Recreation District has a variety of locations available for rental.

Seven picnic pavilions are available at reasonable rates at **Woodland, Glidden and Pleasant Ridge parks**. The pavilions include picnic tables, grills, drinking fountains, electrical outlets and trash cans, and all are within walking distance from playground areas. Reservations for the park pavilions vary depending on residency and pavilion location. Call 618-346-7529 for details. Pavilions may be reserved between April 1 and October 31. Reservations are available on a first-come, first-served basis and must be made in person from 8:30a to 7p, Monday through Thursday, 8:30a-5p on Friday, or 9a to noon on Saturday, at the CARD Administrative Offices, 10 Gateway Drive in Collinsville. Park users must follow all regulations as posted. Liquor is not permitted in any park or pavilion without a permit. A liquor permit is available at the CARD Administrative Office for \$15.

The pavilion at **Willoughby Heritage Farm and Conservation Reserve** is \$75/\$50 with CARD Benefit ID for four hours. The Bank Barn at Willoughby Farm is great for special events and is available for \$135/\$110 with Benefit ID for four hours.

CARD also has indoor spaces for meetings, receptions, parties and other events available at the **CARD Activity Center** and at **Arlington Greens Golf Course**. Visit CollinsvilleRec.com for details.

WHAT IS BENEFIT ID?

'Benefit ID' is the price that CARD residents pay when they show their Benefit ID or "CARD card". Why are there two prices? CARD is a unit of local government – a taxing body – and offers a free Benefit ID card to district residents because those individuals pay taxes to CARD. With the "CARD card", residents receive discounts when registering for CARD programs and using CARD facilities. Find out if you're in the district by checking your property tax bill, voter registration card or by calling CARD at 618-346-7529.

It doesn't matter if you live in Collinsville, Granite City, Troy or St. Louis; anyone can participate in CARD programs and visit CARD facilities. All are welcome at CARD.

PICNIC FUN KITS

Add some extra fun to you family or corporate picnic event by renting one or all of these Picnic Kits from CARD:

- Family Fun Kit Includes a badminton set, horseshoe set, football, Frisbees, softball bat and balls, plastic bat and balls, bases, kickball, and volleyball.
- Volleyball Set Includes a competitive outdoor volleyball set and outdoor synthetic leather volleyball.
- Baggo Game Set Includes a commercial "bags" game set complete with two boards and two sets of bags.

Rental fee: \$15 per set, \$25 for two sets, \$35 for all three sets (add \$50 refundable deposit). All rentals are per day or weekend. Call 618-346-7529 to arrange pick up of your Fun Kit.

REGISTERING FOR PROGRAMS AND EVENTS

Registration deadlines listed in this newsletter. All programs are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Classes that do not meet minimum enrollment are canceled. All registered participants will be notified by telephone of changes. Registration after the deadline date will be accepted only if openings exist. The class fee will not be prorated if the class has started. Participants registering for activities of a strenuous nature are encouraged to seek a physician's approval. CARD programs held in Unit 10 school district facilities will not meet when classes are canceled due to inclement weather and holidays.

- Register over the telephone by calling 618-346-7529. Registration by telephone must be paid for with a credit or debit card.
- Stop by the CARD Activity Center and Administrative Offices, 10 Gateway Drive in Collinsville. The office is open 8:30a-7p, Monday-Thursday; 8:30a-5p on Friday; and 9a-noon on Saturday.
- Print the registration form at www.CollinsvilleRec.com and drop it off at CARD or mail the form to CARD REGISTRATION, 10 Gateway Drive, Collinsville, IL 62234. Make checks payable to CARD and include your driver's license number. Do not send cash. If paying by credit or debit card, include your complete card number, expiration date, and signature.
- If you don't have access to a computer: call 618-346-7529 and someone at the district will mail a registration form to your home.

REFUND/TRANSFER POLICY

You may transfer to another program if space is available and before the second class of a session is held. Transfer can only be made to programs listed in the same program guide. Full refunds for programs will be provided if your request is received prior to the start of the second class meeting or if the District has canceled the program. Full refunds for one-day or two-day programs will be provided if requested prior to the registration deadline. Upon proof, a prorated refund will be provided for medical reasons or if the participant is moving out of town. This policy does not apply to trips. Trip refund requests must be made before the registration deadline date. Requests for refunds after the registration deadline will be provided based upon the minimum number of participants being met or new registrants applying for the program. The District will refund as much of your fee as possible. You may apply for a refund at the CARD Activity Center/Administrative Offices, 10 Gateway Drive. Your receipt or canceled check, or proof of identification, may be required. Refund checks will be mailed within a reasonable period of time, generally a 30 day period.
