**Freedom of Information Act**

The following information is made available in accordance with the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (FOIA):

1. Summary of Purpose: The Collinsville Area Recreation District (CARD) was established in 1990 as a special purpose of government as provided by the Illinois Park District Code.
  - a. Five individuals are elected to serve on the Board of Park Commissioners, the District’s governing board. Commissioners serve six-year terms without compensation. The commissioners elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer to serve one year terms. The commissioners appoint the District’s executive director and legal counsel. The executive director serves as the District’s chief executive officer and carries out the policies set forth by the Board.
  - b. Card was created for the purpose of acquiring, maintaining and operating parks and activities therein, and creating and maintaining recreation opportunities.
